

Important Information about the NIH Public Access Policy and Your Manuscript

Under the NIH Public Access Policy, NIH is requiring that its funded investigators submit to PubMed Central (PMC) all manuscripts accepted after April 7, 2008, resulting from research supported in whole or in part with direct costs from NIH.

You may upload the accepted manuscript any time after acceptance. You will be asked when you want the article to be made free. Please choose the option to make the manuscript free 12 months after publication; this will comply with the Journal's embargo policy. This period of time is consistent with our existing policy to make all content publicly available through HighWire Press 12 months after online publication.
